Student Healthcare Plan

All students aged 16 to 18

All students who are aged between 16 and 18 and in full-time education get these services free:

- prescriptions
- dental treatment
- eye tests
- hearing tests.

All you need to do is prove you are studying full-time.

Part-time students studying 18 hours a week will also get help with these costs.

Students aged 19 and over

Students aged 19 or over and on a low income may be able to get help with the cost of these services. Please see leaflet LF6 for more information.

How to claim

You need to fill in form HF1 saying how much money you have and how much you spend on things like rent and travel.

Refunds

Advice for students

Finding a doctor

You can find a list of doctors in your area online at www.health.biz
To register, you will need to go to a health centre and fill in a form.

Finding a dentist

You can find and register with a dentist online at www.dentalhealth.biz. Be careful as some dentists only take private patients and are expensive. Ask at reception.

Finding an optician

You do not need to register with an optician. Just go to an optician in your local high street and ask for an eye test.

Feeling unwell?

Before you do anything else, you should make an appointment with your doctor.

If your health centre is closed you will be given a phone number for an out-of-hours doctor.

Do not go to the A&E department unless you are very ill or it is an emergency. If you cannot get there on your own, ring the emergency services and ask for an ambulance.
