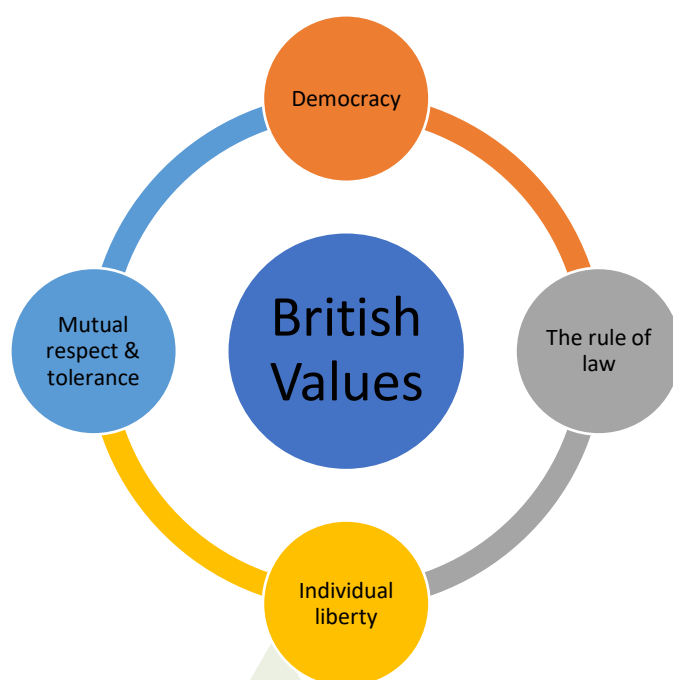
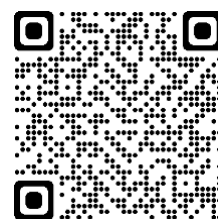


Citizenship Quiz 3 – British Values
